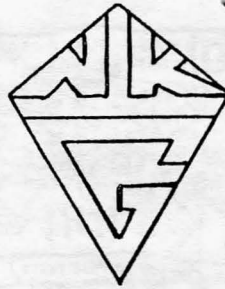

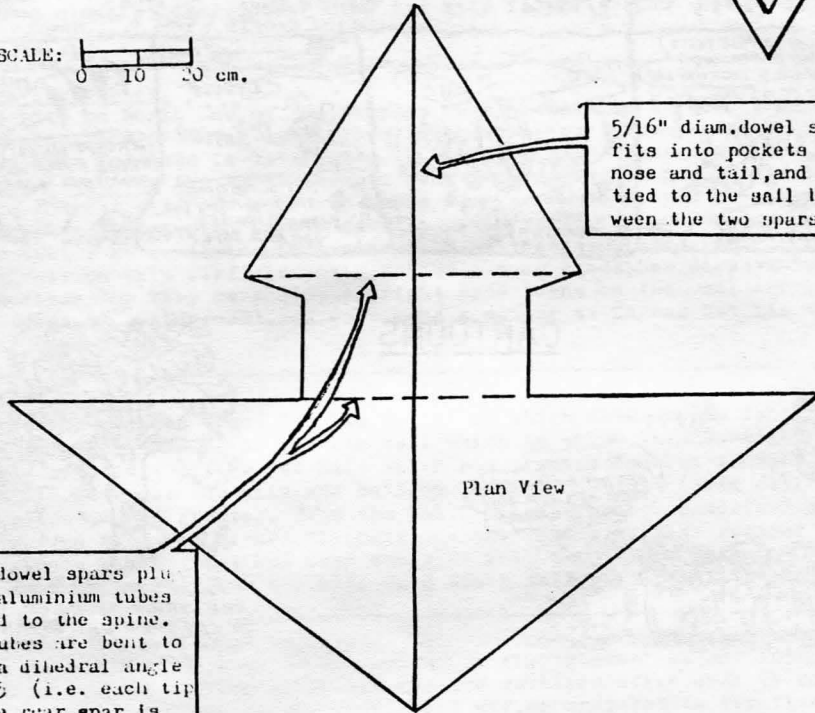


THE DRAGON IN THE SEA



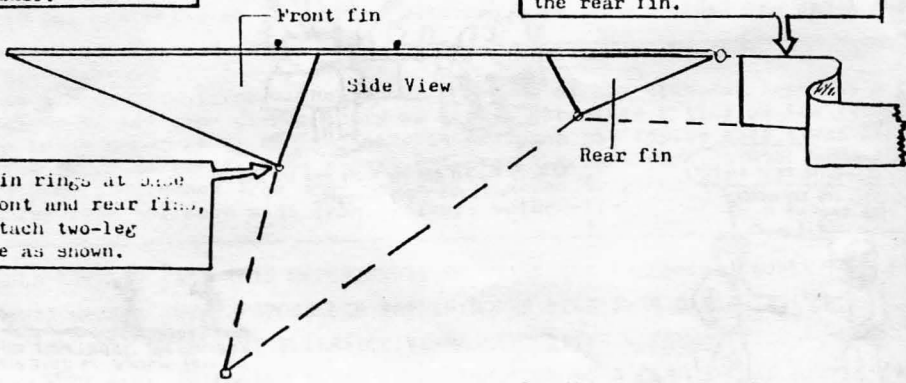
SCALE:  0 10 20 cm.



5/16" diam. dowel spine fits into pockets at nose and tail, and is tied to the sail between the two spars.

1/4" dowel spars plus into aluminium tubes bolted to the spine. The tubes are bent to give a dihedral angle of 7.5 (i.e. each tip of the rear spar is raised 10cm.). The rear spar runs in pockets along the front of the rear sail.

Original flies best with long banner-like tail attached to the rear fin.



Curtain rings at base of front and rear fins, to attach two-leg bridle as shown.
