The best way to make a valentine kite is with a shower cap but shower caps are difficult to get and always too small. So I made a rip stop version. It takes about 60 min to make this kite and if you are fast +- ... 40 min.



Needed materials

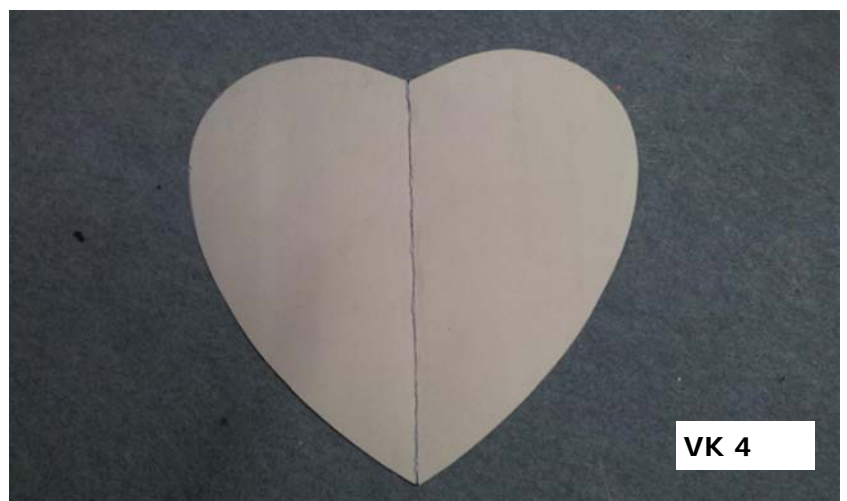
- 1) A Printer
- 2) Scissors
- 3) Spinnaker Tissue
- 4) Sewing Machine
- 5) A Modeling Balloon
- 6) A Little Pump
- 7) Safety Pin
- 8) Some Kite Line

Construction

- 1) Print VK1.jpg
- 2) Print VK2.jpg
- 3) Connect VK1 and VK2 together
- 4) Cut half of the heart template
- 5) Also cut the keel out
- 6) Transfer the template on double spinnaker
- 7) For the front part make 3 air sacs
- 8) Put the keel between the sacs
- 9) See rest of pictures ☺

*If you don't want to cut a keel then better
The top and bottom width = 80 cm of rip

Construction

- 1) Print VK1.jpg
- 2) Print VK2.jpg
- 3) Connect vk1 and vk2 together
- 4) Cut half of the heart template
- 5) Also cut the keel out
- 6) Transfer the template on double spinnaker
- 7) For the first part make 1 cm seam
- 8) Put the keel between the seam
- 9) See rest of pictures ☺

* If you don't want to use a keel then bridle
The top and bottom with +/- 80 cm of rope
